On March 11, 2014 WSIP AM/FM and WKHY AM participated in a Job Fair hosted by the Johnson County School System, Paintsville, Kentucky. The Job Fair targeted two age groups....1) Junior and Senior high School Students and 2) 7th and 8th Grade Middle School Students. WSIP/WKYH was represented by Deanna Meadows, Sales Associate and Scott Ratliff, News Director and IT Coordinator. For middle school students the emphasis was on a general introduction to employment opportunities with small market radio stations covering both broadcast and non broadcast opportunities. For high school students the emphasis was more definitive, addressing radio today with components that appeal to this generation's graduates (i.e. Role of social media in Radio, programming and traffic utilizing integrated technology). The job fair was held at Johnson Central High School, Paintsville Kentucky from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m..
